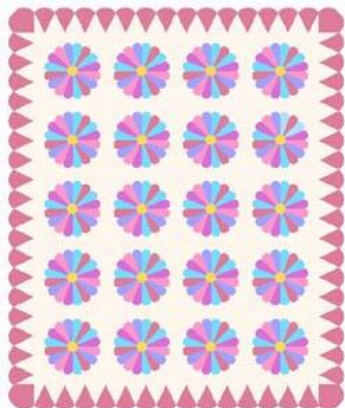

# QUILTING HISTORY



## ***Dresden Plate Quilt Pattern History***

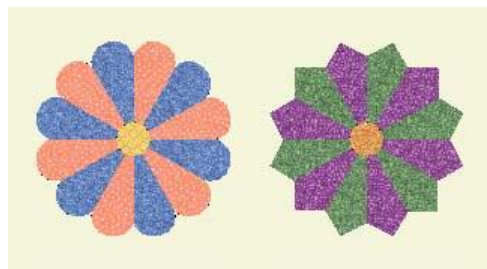


The Dresden Plate quilt pattern was one of the most popular quilts made during the 1920s and 30s. It was first published in the 1920s but not always under the name Dresden Plate.

Grandmother's Sunburst, Friendship Ring, Aster, Dahlia and Sunflower are all names seen for this pattern.

The 1930s version is usually easy to date because of the typical floral prints of the period. Some were made with prettily patterned feed sacks, while a few were done with solid prints. This quilt is made of blocks with fabric appliquéd in a series of radiating "petals" with flat sides. Usually they radiate from a central circle which is more representative of a flower than a plate thus the flower names seen for this pattern.

A few Dresden Plate quilt blocks are made with a smooth outer circle as seen below. More often the ends of the "petals" are rounded or pointed like the illustration below. Occasionally the pointed and curved forms are combined.



## ***The Dresden Connection With the Quilt Name***

The popular name for this quilt, Dresden Plate, reflects the romance of the Victorian Era with it's love of elaborate decoration on household items and décor. Dresden, Germany was a center of 19th century romanticism movement in art, one that included the fine decoration of porcelain. The plates were embellished with elaborate design using flowers, fruits and foliage. The beautiful plates would surely have been admired by women of the early 20th century.

## ***Earlier Designs Related to the Dresden Plate***

Although this pattern was not well known until the late 1920s there were precursors to this pattern in the fan patterns of the late 1800s . You may have seen these fans in a Victorian crazy quilt. Some Dresden Plate blocks appear to be made of 4 fans sewn together. These wheels made of four fans were first seen in wool and later in cotton.





# Tips / Tricks / Recipes



## TIPS FROM QUILTERS AROUND THE WORLD

### Healthy Tips

- ❖ Most people operate the foot pedal of their sewing machine with their right foot only. Why? I think you will like using your left and right foot in turn. It doesn't take long to get used to using your left foot half the time and the alternation of feet is easier on your back. Try it and see for yourself! - Kate in Georgia
- ❖ I have back problems, so bending forward over my ironing board is bad. I use a rolling desk chair for my sewing so I just let my ironing board down to a comfortable sitting height, and butted the straight end up against my sewing table, next to the sewing machine. Those ironing jobs get done comfortably. - Twila in North Dakota
- ❖ Use 2 door stops to raise the back of your machine so that the machine is tilted toward you. Relieves back strain. Usually cost 39 cents at the hardware store." - Jeanne in New Jersey
- ❖ Bed lifters are a great way to raise your cutting table to waist height and save your back. They raise the table 5 1/2 inches which is plenty of height for the average person. Works great. - Pat Leveling, Trenton IL

### Machine Piecing

- ❖ If you need to rip out a seam, give it a quick shot of spray starch and press it first. It's easier to rip out and helps stabilize the fabric so it doesn't distort or fray as much. - Sandra in New York
- ❖ When I stitch "flip and sew corners" (like for a snowball block), I draw (or eyeball) my line on the diagonal of the small square, like the instructions say, but when I sew, I sew a couple of threads LESS than the line (between the line and the corner I am sewing to). When I sew ON the line, the thickness of the fabric makes my "flip and sew corner" too small. - kiskat in Texas

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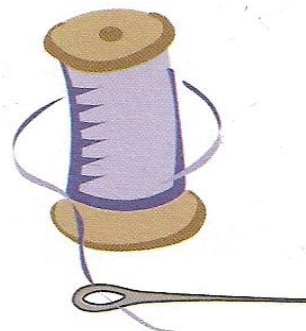
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
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
