2009 "STARGAZER" QUILT CHALLENGE

There's not much time left to complete your "Stargazer" Challenge Quilt. It is not due until the February 26th meeting.

The challenge must contain one or more star patterns with a nine patch in the center of the star. Kits can be purchased from Shirley for \$3.00 that contain directions and a fat quarter of the fabric you must use. You can use up to five additional fabrics in your quilt. The quilt must be a minimum of 26" and there is no maximum size.

If you need more challenge fabric, you can purchase it at Nana's Quilt Shop. It is Hoffman Fabric - Dragonfly Style 885, Color 24. Categories are listed in the directions. The judging will be by our own members and there will also be a "Best Of Show" award. Everyone who enters gets a pin. You can do it! Start Now!
