The idea is to make a quilt that involves water in some way from a pattern that signifies water to your own creation. The possibilities are endless with such a broad category as WATER. Get your creative juices flowing. We would like to have a large participation. The directions and subject were e-mailed before summer, so the snowbirds could start working on it while home for the summer. Just remember the rules. The quilt has to be made between March 26th, 2015 to February, 25th 2016. Size should be no smaller than 16x16 and no larger than 45x60. You must put your name on the back of the quilt, or it will not be judged. The quilts will be judged at the February 25th, 2016 Guild Meeting.
- ❖ 2016 LAKEWOOD RETREAT MARCH 7 10, 2016— Our annual Quilt Retreat for 2016 will again be at Lakewood Retreat Center, 25458 Dan Brown Hill Rd., Brooksville, FL, March 7th to 10th. Hernando Quilters' Honoring Our Vets



Quilter's Corner

The Life Of A Master Quilter
Shirley Kerstetter

Shirley Kerstetter was born in the City of Brotherly Love, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and grew up with one older sister and two younger brothers.

Her mother and aunts were skilled in sewing, embroidery and needlework of all kinds, which contributed to Shirley's learning to sew at an early age, however she and her sister had to work together as neither could reach the Singer Treadle alone.

She majored in Commercial Art in High School and won a 4 year scholarship to the Philadelphia Museum School of Art. Upon graduation and marriage to James Kerstetter, a career in designing children's clothes in Philadelphia ensued.

Later, motherhood and other duties kept her busy at home. She reentered the workforce when her daughter and son were in school and continued her career in the fashion industry.

The next big sewing frenzy was her daughter's wedding and the move to Florida followed, first to Dunedin to be near aging relatives, then to Spring Hill in 1987. After getting settled in their new home, Shirley looked around and thought quilting might be a suitable hobby.

An advertisement in Hernando Today's "Hometown Happenings", told of a new Quilting Guild that was meeting at Evergreen Woods. There was a waiting list and a few months later she received the news that there was an opening. The year was 1990 and the Guild was starting a very special project – making a Heritage Quilt. The committee was headed by Lois Fowler (now deceased) and the quilt layout had 22 blocks depicting the history of Hernando County. As the blocks were being spoken for, Shirley selected the "Hernando Desoto Block." No patterns were available for the buildings, vehicles, sites of interest or characters to be portrayed, so pattern drafting was needed. Her skills fit in perfectly and now that Heritage Quilt hangs in City Hall in Brooksville.

Shirley was recognized on the 20th anniversary of the guild as a "Charter Member" and presented with a certificate and a special pin commemorating the guild's 20th anniversary. She served two terms as secretary and presently is our Sunshine Lady. Shirley loves the guild and has worked in many ways to contribute to its success. As the Guild changes with the years, every new member is welcomed and valued by Shirley. She has been inspired by fellow members and hopes she has been an inspiration to others by entering quilts in fairs, quilt shows and challenges. She has received many awards throughout the years for her wonderful talent and we are very fortunate to have Shirley as a member, good friend and a fellow quilter! Here are just a few of Shirley's wonderful creations including her Hoffman Challenge winning quilt above, and her famous President's Quilt which has been featured in "Quilter Magazine" and many shows throughout the quilting world.


