GUILD NEWS AND NOTES



- ❖ 2024 Membership Dues The 2024 dues will be due in January 2024 and will be \$25.00 for all members renewing. The final deadline for dues is the February meeting. After that there will be a \$5.00 late fee.
- ❖ 2024 New Member Directory Coming In a Few Months— Barb Theriault will be updating pictures of members. This process will take a few months and by March we should have an accurate count of members. Some drop off for various reasons and we also get new members during this time. She will be working on a software that we can marry the picture along with the member info. When this is complete it will probably be updated and sent out about 5 times a year. In the meantime you have been sent an updated list of members..
- ❖ 2024 UFO Challenge Starts in January Your new form was e-mailed out in December. Your lists must be turned in by the January or February meetings. After February only new members will be able to sign up for the challenge. As you complete one of your items on your list you will receive a raffle ticket. The object is to help you complete some of your long overdue tasks. It again will be a \$5.00 entry fee. The entire sum will be given to the winner at the December 24 Holiday Party.
- * 2023 Continued Hernando Quilters Sampler Quilt Penny Dyer is running this challenge which started in May 2023. Participants have been receiving a new block each month, through April 2024. They will get instructions for 12-12.5"(12 inch finished) Blocks. There will be months with 6"blocks, to make x4 for the 12" block. April 2024 will also include sashing and border instructions. Completed quilt should be 56"x70".
- ❖ 2024 Hernando Quilters Sampler Quilt Penny Dyer and her committee have chosen the subject of Houses for our new challenge for 2024 which will start in May. There is a discussion going on to possibly do wonky houses, or straight houses, or maybe combining the two. Penny will address the decision at the January meeting. Participants will receive a new block each month, through April 2025. They will get instructions for 12-10 1/2"(10 inch finished) Blocks.
- ❖ 2024 LAKELAND BUS TRIP TO EXPO We will be doing a bus trip to the Lakeland Sewing Expo on March 15, 2024 which is a Friday (2nd day of Expo). Sandy Wesley has a sign-up sheet on her table for those who wish to go so that we have an idea of how many will be attending. The cost will be \$45.00 per person which includes admission fee, parking and driver tip. The bus will leave at 8:30am sharp from the Weeki Wachee Shopping Center, Cortez & US 19 . We will attend the show from 10:00am to 3:00pm and arrive back home approximately 5:30pm.
- ❖ 2024 LAKE YALE RETREAT Monday, March 4th to Thurs March 7th 2024 Karen Pilon has secured the date for our 2024 Retreat at Lake Yale. We will be in the lighter, but a little smaller room in the building next to the Magnolia Dining Hall. 


