#### President's Message





Dear Friends.

A few weeks ago, I was speaking with a gentleman on the phone trying to resolve a problem. I revealed that I belonged to a quilting guild. His response was "I heard that guilting was becoming popular again". I chuckled and said "Well, actually...".

My curiosity sent me down the internet rabbit hole to see what recent surveys indicate on how much money 'we' quilters spend to support the economy and who we are. Every year Premier Needle Arts releases the results of its annual Quilter's Survey. Here is some of those results from the 2022 survey:

- Dedicated guilters estimate the average dollar value of their "stash" to be \$3,677 and their guilting tools and supplies to be \$8,542;
- The average quilter is retired and is in her 60's, has been quilting for over 10 years and has a household income of \$60k+;
- We start 10-12 quilt projects each year (the survey doesn't indicate if we finish them);
- An average of six hours per week is spent on quilting projects;
- Approximately four sewing machines are owned;
- Our fabric is mainly purchased from independent guilt shops:
- We are online every day doing research, shopping and watching YouTube for guilt related information;
- There are currently 9-11 million active quilters in the United
- And by 2026-27 the amount that quilters spend is expected to be \$5 billion!

#### **GUILD NEWS AND NOTES**



- ❖ 2024 Membership Dues The 2024 dues was due in January 2024 and will be \$25.00 for all members renewing. The final deadline for dues is the February meeting. After that there was a \$5.00 late fee.
- ❖ 2024 New Member Directory Coming In a Few Months— Barb Theriault will be updating pictures of members. This process will take a few months and by April meeting we should have an accurate count of members. Some drop off for various reasons and we also get new members during this time. She will be working on a software that we can marry the picture along with the member info. When this is complete it will probably be updated and sent out about 4 times a year. In the meantime you will be sent an updated list of members. She will continue to update the regular roster as well to avoid any unforeseen problems with the new Directory..
  - **2024** Cookbook Project Patty Richey has volunteered to head up the Guild Cookbook Project. She is in need of recipes from all members of at least 3 recipes. So far she has only received 100 recipes and needs at least 300 for the book. Please continue to send in your recipes to her as soon as possible.
- ❖ 2024 UFO Challenge Started in January Your new form was e-mailed out in December. Your lists must have been turned in by the January or February meetings. After February only new members will be able to sign up for the challenge. As you complete one of your items on your list you will receive a raffle ticket. The object is to help you complete some of your long overdue tasks. It again will be a \$5.00 entry fee. The entire sum will be given to the winner at the December 24 Holiday Party.
- ❖ 2023 Continued Hernando Quilters Sampler Quilt Penny Dyer is running this challenge which started in May 2023. Participants have been receiving a new block each month, through April 2024. They will get instructions for 12-12.5"(12 inch finished) Blocks. There will be months with 6"blocks, to make x4 for the 12" block. April 2024 will also include sashing and border instructions. Completed quilt s should be 56"x70".
- ❖ 2024 Hernando Quilters Sampler Quilt Penny Dyer and her committee have chosen the subject of Houses for our new challenge for 2024 which will start in May. Participants will receive a new block each month, through April 2025. They will get instructions for each block along with the pattern. In April 2025 they will receive instructions on finishing the quilt.
- ❖ 2025 LAKE YALE RETREAT Monday, March 3rd to Thurs March 6th 2025 Karen Pilon has secured the date for our 2025 Retreat at Lake Yale. We will be in the lighter, but a little smaller room in the building next to the Magnolia Dining Hall. Our Pods will be 4 Pods instead of 6 Pods due to limited space, so It was asked of people at the 2024 Retreat to give a \$165 deposit made out to Hernando Quilters' Guild, to our treasurer, Raelee Russavage, if they wish to go in 2025. The cost has increased to \$345.00 for a double room and \$390 for a single room. The final deposit of \$180.00 is due at the October 2024 meeting. For your advanced planning Fat Quarters for 2024 Retreat have not been chosen yet. Stay tuned for more info. When colors are chosen, please adhere to the colors requested. # Four Colors of Fall Orange, Green, Gold and Brown



The challenge is to make a quilt using the four colors of fall. Members may make either a wall hanging (no larger than 30X30), or a Lap Quilt (no larger tan 45 X50).

We encourage everyone participating to use your imagination.

You may use embellishments on your quilt such as buttons, yoyo's, beads, ribbons, etc.

Some suggestions are leaves, acorns, horn of plenty, pumpkins, vegetables, sun flowers, scarecrows or a variety of blocks using the four colors.

Have fun making your quilt for the challenge.!

Categories: Entries will be judged in one category.

Judging: We will again try to bring in an outside judge and will have "Best of Show", 1st

place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Guild members will vote for the winner of "Viewer's

Choice."

Quilting: You must have hand or machine quilting on your entry.

Size: A wall hanging (no larger than 30x30), or a lap quilt (no larger than 45x50).

Due Date: February 27, 2025 – Guild Meeting

Rules: You are not allowed to use a project that has been made previous to this challenge.

It must be made between March 28, 2024 and February 27, 2025. There will be a sign-up sheet when you turn in your entry and you must have your name on the

back of the entry.




